Please complete the FSA maps indicating the date, planting method, crop, previous crop, seeding rate (bushel or pounds per acre) and whether spring or fall manure was applied. Please submit seed tags for purchased seed and seed tests for home grown seed. The seed tags need to be signed by the Operator and any seed tests not in the Operator's name shall also be signed. Then return the completed maps and seed tags/tests back to the district using the above email addresses.

If you have applied for aerial seeding your pilot will need to complete the FSA maps and the <u>"aerial and aerial ground"</u> seeding invoice.

In the event you do not have access to email or a scanning device, please complete the maps with the necessary information mentioned above and mail back along with seed tags/seed tests to the district.
